Based in Monticello, Utah, in the United States, Four Corners School creates lifelong learners of all ages and backgrounds who share a passion for experiencing and protecting the Colorado Plateau. It accomplishes this mission through adventure, education, service, and conservation programs.

The Colorado Plateau is one of the most geographically diverse areas in America and home to the Navajo, Hopi, Paiute, Hispanic and Ute people. However, decreasing economic opportunities, irresponsible resource extraction, pollution, loss of cultures, and a generation of children increasingly separated from having fun outdoors threatens the health and prosperity of the inhabitants of this region. Four Corners School is committed to ensuring a prosperous, healthy future for the natural and human communities of the Colorado Plateau.

Four Corners School operates four different programs to build the next generation of outdoor enthusiasts and protect the Colorado Plateau. For example, the Canyon Country Youth Corps (CCYC) provides approximately 50 participants, mostly from the Navajo Nation, with education, employment, and leadership training while at the same time restoring natural resources.



“If it was not for the CCYC, I don’t know where I would be now. I have graduated high school, and I am living drug free,” said one participant of CCYC



Another Four Corners School program, the Bioregional Outdoor Education Project (BOEP), is a regional teacher training initiative. BOEP empowers teachers to utilize the Colorado Plateau as an educational resource, inspiring kids to discover the land and become lifelong active learners.
